{After lesson 77}

Here are your ABC's. We'll use this alphabet strip to practice saying letter names. I'll say the whole first row listen. {Say all letters as you touch under each one.} Now you touch under and say all the letter names in the first row. {Child says letter names.}

•To correct if the child says the wrong letter name or hesitates for more than a few seconds:

*This letter name is \_\_\_\_. What's the letter name? {Start row over.}*

{After lesson 79}

{Point to middle row.} Here are your ABC's written the new way. I'll say the whole middle row listen. {Say all letters as you touch under each one.} Now you touch under and say all the letter names in the middle row. {Child says letter names.}

•To correct if the child says the wrong letter name or hesitates for more than a few seconds:

*This letter name is \_\_\_\_. What's the letter name? {Start row over.}*

Now you touch under and say all the letter names in the top row AND in the middle row. {Repeat until firm.}

{After lesson 81}

{Point to last row.} Here are your ABC's in capital letters. I'll say the whole row listen. {Say all letters as you touch under each one.} Now you touch under and say all the capital letters in the last row. {Child says letter names.}

•To correct if the child says the wrong letter name or hesitates for more than a few seconds:

*This capital letter is \_\_\_\_. What's the capital letter? {Start row over.}*

Now you touch under and say all the letter names in the top row, in the middle row, and in the last row.. {Repeat until firm.}
